STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

ACT 33 OF 2021.- It is considered necessary to amend the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), to re-define the words “Special Board”, in order to constitute separate Special Board consisting of the Chief Minister, the Minister-in-charge of Parliamentary Affairs and Legislation, the Minister-in-charge of Finance, the Chairman in case of the State legislative Council and the Speaker in case of the State Legislative Assembly, as the case may be.

Hence the Bill.

THE KARNATAKA STATE CIVIL SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2020

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 5th day of October, 2021)

An Act further to amend the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978.

Whereas, it is expedient further to amend the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

Be it enacted by the Karnataka State Legislature in the seventy first year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Karnataka State Civil Services (Amendment) Act, 2020.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 2.- In the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990), in section 2, for clause (4a), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(4a) ‘Special Board’ means the Board consisting of the Chief Minister, the Minister-in-charge of Parliamentary Affairs and Legislation, the Minister-in-charge of Finance, the Chairman in case of the Karnataka Legislative Council and the Speaker in case of the Karnataka Legislative Assembly, as the case may be”.
