NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), the Government of Karnataka, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1994, namely:-

RULES

1. Title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2.Amendment of rule 8-A.- (In the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1994, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 8- A, in sub-rule (2), after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely,-

“Provided also that, notwithstanding anything contained in these rules any Mineral which are classified as Minor Mineral by the Central Government vide Notification No.S.0.423(E) dated:10.02.2015 included in Major Mineral mining leases prior to this notification shall be continued as associated mineral of that mining lease and period shall be co-terminus with mining lease”.

3. Amendment of rule 32.- In rule 32 of the said rules,-

(i) in sub-rule (11), for the numbers and words “nine months from the date of commencement of the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession (Second Amendment) Rules, 2020”, the numbers and words “twelve months from the date of commencement of the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2021” shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-rule (12), for the numbers and words “four months from the date of commencement of the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession (second Amendment) Rules, 2020”, the numbers and words “six months from the date of commencement of the Karnataka Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2021” shall be substituted.
