The Karnataka Ministers Residence (Furnishing) Rules 1994

GOVERNMENT OF KARANTAKA NOTIFICATION

No. DPAR 149 GAM 93.dated Bangalore, 17th March 1994.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Karnataka Minister's Salaries and Allowances Act, 1956 (Karnataka Act No. 5 of 1957), the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Minister's Residence (Furnishing) Rules, 1994.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 19th November 1991.

2. Definition:- In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- (1) 'Act' means the Karnataka Minister's Salaries and Allowances Act, 1956(Karnataka Act 5 of 1957);
- (2) 'Form' means form appended to these rules;
- (3) 'Minister' includes a 'Minister of State' and 'Deputy Minister'

3. Scale of furnishings:- (1) The residence provided to a Minister under the Act shall be furnished at the scales specified in the Annexure to these rules.

(2) The expenditure for furnishing the residence of Minister under sub-rule (1) during the period of 5 years shall not exceed Rs. 5.00 lakhs.

- (3) The annual expenditure on repairs and replacements of the articles provided to the residence of a Minister shall not exceed ten percent of the total cost of the furnishings provided thereto.

4. Furnishing Articles are the property of the State Government:- (1) Every furnishing articles required to be provided to the residence of a Minister shall be the property of the State Government. It shall be furnished after entering them in the register maintained in Form 'A' by the officer in charge in Public Works Department and after obtaining an acknowledgement from the Minister or from the Private Secretary to the Minister authorised in his behalf. A duplicate copy of the list of such articles furnished shall also be provided to him.

(2) Whenever a Minister relinquishes his office, the articles provided to the residence under sub-rule (1) of rule 3, shall be handed over by the Minister concerned to the Officer in charge in Public Works Department along with the list of those articles.

5. Maintenance and Up-keep of furnished articles:- (1) The expenditure on maintenance of the articles provided under these rules, in good condition and or towards repairs of such articles due to normal wear and tear shall be borne by the State Government.

(2) The officer in charge in Public Works Department shall take necessary steps for up-keep of the costly articles such as all Teak Wood /Rose Wood furniture, Sofas, Television, Refrigerator, VCP/VCR, Carpets etc., in good condition by getting them repaired and polished periodically.

(3) Breakable articles such as glass ware, crockeries etc., which are not used and are found unserviceable in the opinion of the Public Works Department shall be disposed of as per provisions of relevant rules.

6. Repeal and savings:- (1) The Karnataka Residence of Ministers, Ministers of State and Deputy Ministers (Furnishing) Rules, 1956 are hereby repealed:

Provided that the said repeal shall not affect the previous operation of the said rules or any things duly done or suffered thereunder or affect any right, liability or obligation acquired, accrued or incurred under the said rules.
